


## **GROUND SNOW LOAD**



## New York State and Warren County

Building regulations in New York State require roof construction to withstand estimated amount of snow. The "snow load" is a measurement of the weight of the heaviest snow load likely to occur in a two-month period in a certain region. The statewide and Warren County maps show the snow load requirements.

For building sites at elevations above 1000 feet, the ground snow load should be increased from the mapped value by 2 pounds per square foot (PSF).
